

Police Bike Program

To help ensure the safety of Irving's growing population where space is limited and crowds are present, some police officers cover their beats on bikes. The Police Department has 41 bikes available to provide officers with greater flexibility by allowing them to access places that squad cars cannot, such as behind buildings or other confined spaces.

Since 1994, bikes have been used in crowded areas such as shopping center parking lots during the busy holiday season or at large-scale events. With increased development in areas like Heritage Crossing and Las Colinas, bicycle patrol officers will play an even larger role in the city's public safety initiatives.
