## RED LIGHT ENFORCEMENT CAMERA SYSTEM

Red light enforcement camera systems are being added to four initial locations in Irving to help reduce the severity of accidents caused by red-light offenders. A 30-day warning period follows the installation in which offenders will receive a warning of violation in the mail. After the 30-day warning period, offenders will receive a notice of violation with a fine. The first two violations will cost \$75 each. A third violation within a 12-month period will cost \$150. The offense is considered civil, not criminal. Call (972) 721-2646.
